## Notice of Bridge Replacement Work

Dear Residents of Butler County:

The construction work to replace the bridge on NW Diamond Road over Rock Creek, just south of NW 30th Street, is expected to begin on Monday, November 17, 2014. The construction work to replace the bridge located north of NW 30<sup>th</sup> on NW Diamond Road over Fourmile Creek is currently under way. **The road at these bridge sites will be closed during construction.** B & B Bridge Company LLC is the prime contractor for both of the bridge projects. They will have two crews working on the two bridge projects. Each project has 110 working days assigned.

Both projects consist of removing the existing bridge and constructing new reinforced concrete haunched slab bridges. Butler County is responsible for the construction inspection of these projects. We will be constantly communicating with the EMS agencies for emergency vehicle access (fire trucks, ambulances, etc.). We ask for your patience with this temporary endeavor and to slow down and exercise caution when driving alternate routes to avoid the construction.

All work is being performed with the intent of making improvements to our roadway and of service to our county residents. If you have any concerns, please contact Bronson Webb at the Butler County Engineering Office. Personnel will frequently be on the project sites.
